ABOUT THE WEBINAR

Indian poultry industry comprises of two major sectors viz. organized (Commercial) and unorganized (Backyard) poultry. In spite of marked growth of Indian poultry, the backyard sector is still known as low input and low output venture. This sector is contributing almost 30% of the total poultry population and interestingly, around 2.57 % of total Indian population (31.37 million) is engaged for their livelihood. Among the leading states, West Bengal ranks first in backyard poultry (12.61%) with a recognized breed, Haringhata Black. Because of their scavenging habits, better tropical adaptability and disease resistance, they are widely accepted and used for alleviation of poverty, hunger and malnutrition. Comparatively tough meat with less fat, premium price of brown shelled eggs and local demands creates huge opportunity for employment and women empowerment. Lack of knowledge, skills and exposure of the entrepreneurs are the major constraints of backyard poultry to keep pace with the commercial enterprises. However, learning, discussion and interaction with the scientific stature may resolve the limits and widen up the new horizon for the backyard poultry to reach at new height.
