Schedule for Entrance Test for admission to **M.Sc. Agriculture / M.Sc. Horticulture / M.Sc. Forestry** **For the Session 2019-2020**

1. M.Sc. entrance test will be conducted module wise for Faculty of Agriculture from the session 2019-20.
2. The entrance test for admission to M.Sc. (Agriculture) for Crop Protection module, Crop Production module and M.Sc. (Horticulture) will be held tentatively on 23.07.2019

On 23/07/2019, Time:

For Crop Production module – 10:00 a.m to 11:30 a.m

For Crop Protection module – 12:30 p.m to 2:00 p.m

For Horticulture module - 3:00 p.m to 4:30 p.m

3. The entrance test for admission to Social Science module, Basic Science module and M.Sc. Forestry will be held tentatively on 24.07.2019

On 24/07/2019, Time:

For Social Science module - 10:00 a.m to 11:30 a.m

For Basic Science module – 12:30 p.m to 2:00 pm

For Forestry module - 3:00 p.m to 4:30 p.m

4. Venue: Uttar Banga Krishi Viswavidyalaya, Pundibari, Coochbehar.
5. Duration of the Test – 1 hours 30 minutes; Total marks – 100
6. Questions: – 15 questions of 2 marks = 30 marks; 2 questions of 5 marks = 10 marks; 60 MCQ type Questions with four alternatives answer, each of 1 marks (60x1=60).
7. Qualifying marks of the Entrance Test - 35 % for General, OBC-A & OBC-B categories and 30% for SC, ST & PWD categories of the Test.
8. There will be no negative marks for wrong answer.
9. The final merit list will be prepared based on marks obtained in Higher Secondary (marks of 5 best subjects), B.Sc. and Entrance test.
10. The syllabus for entrance test in M.Sc. (Agriculture), M.Sc. (Horticulture) and M.Sc. (Forestry) are *available in the University Website www.ubkv.ac.in*

Note - ##

1. Merely appearing at Entrance Test by a candidate does not ensure his / her eligibility for admission.

2. Final admission is subject to the verification of all documents and fulfillment of all criteria, published in the admission notification for admission to M.Sc. courses for the session 2019-20 strictly.
3. In any case Students identified passing with three years degree course are not eligible for appearing in Entrance Test in spite of his/her name may include in eligibility list for Entrance Test.
4. Those who have not uploaded their last semester mark sheet & final mark sheet are requested to bring the original & photocopy (both side) of all mark sheets including final mark sheet positively on the day of the entrance test for submission; otherwise their candidature will be cancelled.
5. Candidates have to bring two recent passport size photographs, one photo identity card (like Aadhaar Card, Pan Card, Driving Licence etc.), Downloaded Admit Card and original marksheets of B.Sc. examinations as applicable at the time of entrance test for verification of Degree Programme and year of study failing which his/her application shall liable to be cancelled.
6. Applicants securing less than overall 60% marks for Gen/OBC and 50% marks for SC/ST/PWD in H.S. examination are advised not to appear on entrance test however, the applicants even though qualifying in the entrance test, shall not be eligible for admission in the M.Sc. degree Programmes.
