**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- ❖ *Eligible Candidates who have attended 1<sup>st</sup> Counselling on 08/08/2019 are only eligible to participate in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Counselling.*
- ❖ *Candidates must report for admission at Dr. Pranab Gayen Memorial Hall, UBKV, Pundibari, Cooch Behar on 09.09.2019 between 11.00 am and 12.00 noon positively.*
- ❖ *Candidates who fail to report within stipulated time will not be considered for admission.*
- ❖ *Candidates must bring all testimonials/certificates, in original as indicated in the admission notification, for verification by Admission office. They shall also bring a set of self-attested photocopies of all testimonials/certificates.*
- ❖ *Candidates belong to OBC category must bring OBC certificate in prescribed format (available in the University website) issued on or after 01.04.2018 for claiming admission under OBC category.*
- ❖ *Candidates must produce domicile certificate in prescribed format (available in the University website) for claiming admission in Undergraduate Programme.*
- ❖ *Candidates, if offered admission, need to pay around Rs. 18,500/- (including hostel admission), by credit/debit card.*
- ❖ *The decision of admission committee shall be final and binding on candidates*
- ❖ *In case of non-availability of eligible ICAR candidates, the seat will be filled up from merit panel of Candidates*
