Dr. Avijit Halder, Principal Scientist, ATARI-Kolkata suggested that innovative technologies for OFTs and impact assessment of the same at field level.



Soil health should be taken into consideration while planning on OFTs and FLDs and holistic approaches should be taken into next programmes. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor emphasized that OFT's source of technologies and its implication be considered first. He emphasized on entrepreneur approach aspects of Agriculture and impressed upon technology inventory for KVKs with the help of University.
