#### On the day of counseling/ document verification, the following documents need to be produced

- (b) All certificates that has been uploaded during application and the final degree certificate, in ORIGINAL

- (c) Character certificate from the Head of the Institute, last attended.
- (d) Migration certificate to be submitted within 1stsemester.
- (e) Anti-ragging declaration in the given format (to be given within 2 weeks of admission).
- (f) The downloaded application form and original copies of all above documents have to be submitted at the time of verification, failing which his/her application will be treated as cancelled.
- (g) Domicile certificate for candidates of West Bengal as per the University format
- (h) Any other document uploaded during application need to be produced in original

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

- (a) Students passed with three years Bachelors' degree course are **NOT ELIGIBLE**.
- (b) The minimum age limit for admission to M.Sc. courses is 21 years as on 31.12.2024.
- (c) Candidates must have passed their Bachelors' degree in Agriculture/Horticulture or Forestry or have appeared in final examination in the relevant subject under four year Agriculture/Horticulture/Forestry undergraduate programme from any recognized Indian/Foreign University.
- (d) Candidates must have obtained at least 60% marks or its equivalent OGPA (6.00 out of 10.00 or 3.40 out of 5.00 or 2.70 out of 4.00 or 2.00 out of 3.00) in Bachelors' degree for Unreserved and OBC category and 55% marks or its equivalent OGPA (5.50 out of 10.00 or 3.20 out of 5.00 or 2.50 out of 4.00 or 1.80 out of 3.00) in Bachelors' degree for SC/STcandidates.
- (e) Candidates of Unreserved and OBC categories must have passed their Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination with at least 60% marks in aggregate of 5 (five) best subjects including English as compulsory and for SC/ST category candidates the same shall be 50% marks in aggregate of 5 (five) best subjects including English as compulsory.

[Admission of PWD candidates will be subjected to the fitness certificate issued by the medical officer of the University]

- 1. Duration of the Test 1 hour; Total marks –60
- 2. Questions pattern: MCQ type Questions with four alternatives, each of 1 mark(60x1=60).
- 3. Qualifying marks of the Entrance Test 35 % for General, OBC-A & OBC-B categories and 30% for SC, ST categories of the Test.
- 4. There will be negative marks for MCQ is 0.25 for each wrong answer.
- 5. The final merit list will be prepared based on marks obtained in Higher Secondary (marks of 5 best subjects including English as compulsory), B.Sc. and Entrance test.
