FOREWORD

In due compliance of ICAR V Deans' Committee Recommendations, the Faculty Councils of the Faculties of Agriculture and Horticulture in a joint meeting on 29.08.2016 made exhaustive discussions on the detailed syllabuses/courses and other guidelines in presence of Dean and other teachers of the Faculty of Technology and two external members from each of the Faculty Council and decided to adopt the proposed uniform nomenclature of Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate degrees and the syllabus of B.Sc.(Hons.)Agriculture and B.Sc.(Hons.)Horticulture upto sixth semester with minor modifications within permissible limit as suggested by ICAR. As academic session had already started from August, 2016 at both the Colleges at main campus and the newly established College of Agriculture at RRS, Old Alluvial Zone, Majhian, Dakshin Dinajpur, the new syllabus and evaluation system were introduced with the kind approval of the Vice-Chancellor from the said academic session. The decisions of the Faculty Council were approved in the 28th meeting of Academic Council held on 12.01.2017 and finally approved by the 60th meeting of Executive Council held on 16th January, 2017. Total credit load for UG programme has been worked out at 186 of which Student READY programme consists of 40 credits. It has been agreed upon to review the entire syllabus and workout detailed plan of works for student READY programme and the elective courses in subsequent meeting of the Faculty Council.

It is also mentionworthy that as per IÇAR V Deans' Committee Recommendations Student READY programme has been introduced from the 8th semester outgoing students (who are going to pass out within a few days) w.e.f. February, 2017. Three components implemented in the Students READY programme include (i) Hands on Training/Experiential Learning, (ii) Village Attachment/Stay Programme(RAWE) and (III) Industrial exposure.

The help and cooperation received from the Heads of the Departments and all other teachers of the Faculty in formulating the syllabus are highly appreciated and acknowledged. I hope this compilation will be helpful for the students, teachers and others.
