# Subject: Enhanced rainfall activity very likely to continue over the districts of North Bengal during 24<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2023.

Due to passing of the monsoon trough through Meerut, Azamgarh, Patna, Deoghar, Diamond Harbour and thence southeast wards to East Central Bay of Bengal and a trough runs from northeast Uttar Pradesh to east Assam across Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal and strong moisture incursion from Bay of Bengal, enhanced rainfall activity is likely over the districts of West Bengal during 24th to 26th August, 2023.

**FORECAST:** Light to moderate rain with thunder very likely to occur at most places over the districts of West Bengal.

## WARNING: NORTH BENGAL 24.08.2023

**ORANGE WARNING:** 1) Heavy to very heavy rain with Extremely Heavy rain (>20 cm) is very likely to occur at one or two places over Alipurduar and Jalpaiguri districts.

2) Heavy to very heavy rain (07-20 cm) is very likely to occur at one or two places over Kalimpong and CoochBehar districts.

**YELLOW WARNING:** Heavy rain (7-11 cm) very likely to occur at one or two places over Darjeeling, North Dinajpur districts.

#### 25.08.2023

**ORANGE WARNING:** Heavy to Very heavy rain (7-20 cm) is very likely to occur at one or two places over Jalpaiguri, Kalimpong and Alipurduar districts.

**YELLOW WARNING:** Heavy rain (7-11 cm) very likely to occur at one or two places over Darjeeling and Cooch Behar districts.

#### 26.08.2023

**YELLOW WARNING:** Heavy rain (7-11 cm) very likely to occur at one or two places over Jalpaiguri, Kalimpong and Alipurduar districts.

### Possible Impact for North Bengal:

- 1. Landslide in hilly areas of Darjeeling and Kalimpong districts due to intense spells of rainfall.
- 2. Rise in water level of rivers of districts of North Bengal.
- 3. Water logging in the low lying area of Municipality/Corporation.
- 4. Damage to horticulture and standing crops & vegetables in the field.
- 5. Reduction in visibility during heavy rainfall.

6. Moderate Flash Flood risk likely over few water sheds & neighbourhood of Cooch Behar, Alipurduar and Jalpaiguri districts.

#### **Possible Precaution:**

- 1. Do not use fertilizer & pesticides during 24th 26th August, 2023 as it may wash out.
- 2. Maintain proper drainage channel.
- 3. People are advised to take safer places during thunderstorm and lightning.
- 4. Keep the cattle away from rivers. People are advised to take safer places during thunderstorm and lightning.
- 5. Harvest matured fruits and Vegetables.
