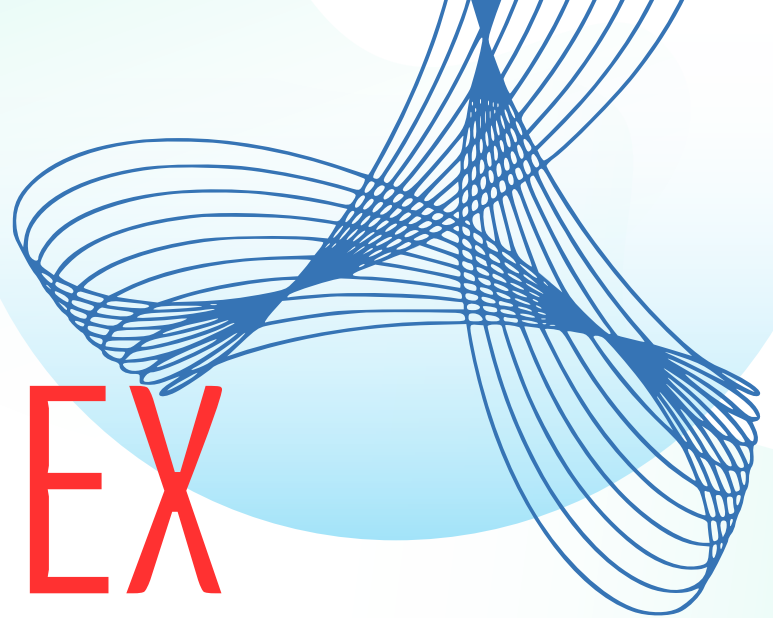

- **Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUP):**

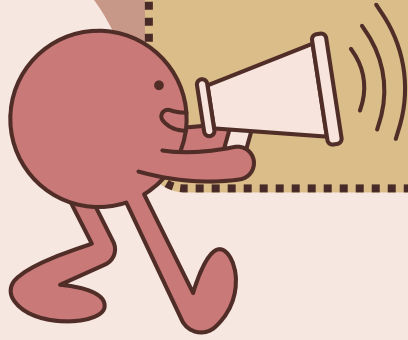
Emphasis was given on the flexibility, multidisciplinary learning, and research orientation provided under FYUP, promoting holistic development and employability.

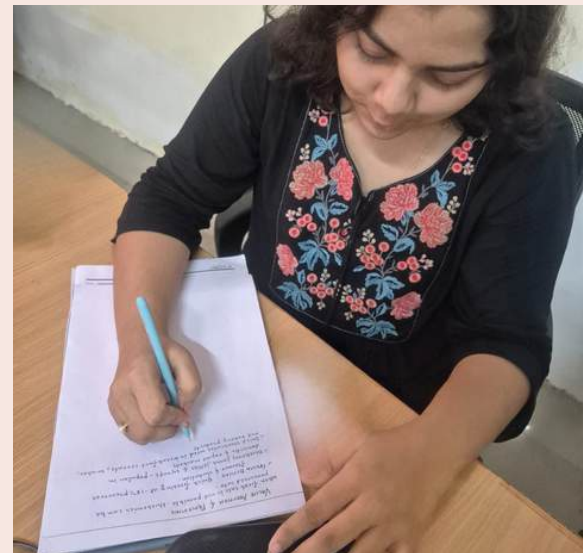

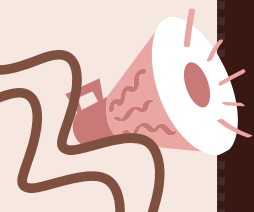

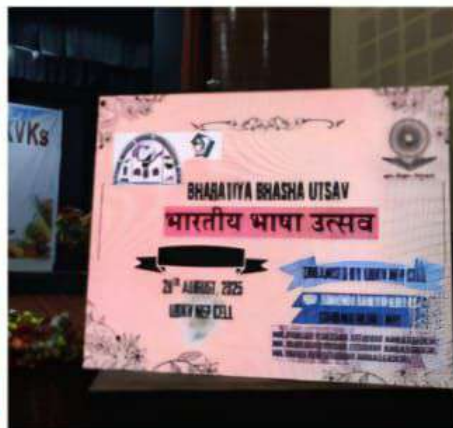
