English	1(One)	Date: 12/11/2024 Time: 11.00 a.m.	<p>Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Masters Degree level in English along with relaxations applicable to specified categories, as explained in the Note 1.</p> <p>The candidate preferably has cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC (CSIR) or similar test accredited by the UGC like NET/SLET/SET.</p> <p>NOTE</p> <p>1: Relaxation of Marks</p> <p>A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Masters level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently-abled (physically and visually differently-abled) / Other Backward Classes (non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions.</p> <p>The minimum qualifying marks of 55% is relaxable by 5% marks (from 55% to 50%) at the Master level for Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Masters degree prior to September 19, 1991.</p> <p>The eligibility marks or 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.</p> <p>All the essential qualifications must have been obtained from a recognized University/ Institute. By a recognized University / Institute is meant a University / Institute affiliated to UGC/other statutory apex bodies/ or recognized by the State or Central Government as a centre of higher learning. In case of a foreign University, the Degree concerned should be recognized as equivalent to its Indian counterpart by the Association of Indian Universities.</p>

Age: 37 years or less. Minimum age of any candidate has to be at least 21 years (as on 01 January 2024). Relaxation in maximum age of 5 years for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidates shall be admissible. Age may be relaxed for exceptionally qualified /experienced candidates.

Remuneration: The remuneration shall be fixed considering sixteen effective weeks of instruction in one semester. Depending on credit-hour of the course, the fixed remuneration shall be calculated. Remunerations for conducting theory (one hour) and practical (two hours) classes will be admissible at the rate of Rs. 800/- and Rs. 1200/-, respectively. In addition to this Rs. 1000/- will be paid for setting question paper and evaluating midterm answer scripts, Rs. 2000/- will be paid for end-term question paper moderation and evaluating answer scripts, and Rs. 1000/- will be paid for conducting and
