A walk-in-interview will be held at *Uttar Banga Krishi Viswavidyalaya*, P.O. Pundibari, Dist-Cooch Behar for the posts of **Part-time Guest Lecturer** in various disciplines on purely temporary basis for **Main Campus, Pundibari, Cooch Behar (Sl. No. 1 to Sl. No. 10)** and **College of Agriculture, Majhian, Dakshin Dinajpur (Sl. No. 1 to Sl. No. 4)**.

Tech. in Civil Engineering) along with relaxations applicable to specified categories, as explained in the Note 1 . The candidate preferably has cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC (CSIR) or similar test accredited by the UGC like NET/SLET/SET. NOTE 1: Relaxation of Marks A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Masters level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently-abled (physically and visually differently-abled) / Other Backward Classes (non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions. However, differently-abled (physically and visually) candidates are not eligible for any marks relaxation in Physical Education discipline. The minimum qualifying marks of 55% is relaxable by 5% marks (from 55% to 50%) at the Master level for Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Masters degree prior to September 19, 1991. The eligibility marks or 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures. All the essential qualifications must have been obtained from a recognized University/ Institute. By a recognized University / Institute is meant a University / Institute affiliated to UGC/other statutory apex bodies/ or recognized by the State or Central Government as a centre of higher learning. In case of a foreign University, the Degree concerned should be recognized as equivalent to its Indian counterpart by the Association of Indian Universities.

Age: 37 years or less. Minimum age of any candidate has to be at least 21 years (as on 01 January 2022). Relaxation in maximum age of 5 years for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidates shall be admissible. Age may be relaxed for exceptionally qualified /experienced candidates.

Remuneration: The remuneration shall be fixed considering sixteen effective weeks of instruction in one semester. Depending on credit-hour of the course, the fixed remuneration shall be calculated. Remunerations for conducting theory (one hour) and practical (two hours) classes will be admissible at the rate of Rs. 800/- and Rs. 1200/-, respectively. In addition to this Rs. 1000/- will be paid for setting question paper and evaluating midterm answer scripts, Rs. 2000/- will be paid for end-term question paper moderation and evaluating answer scripts, and Rs. 1000/- will be paid for conducting and evaluating for practical examination. No additional payment will be made for conducting and evaluating back examinations (if any) for the concerned course. The total fixed remuneration for a particular course will be rounded off to the next Rs. 500/-

Venue: Registrar's Chamber, *Uttar Banga Krishi Viswavidyalaya (UBKV), Pundibari, Cooch Behar.*

Interested persons having requisite qualification and experience in the respective areas may appear in the interview with application in plain paper. The application must contain details of his/her bio-data along with attested copies of certificate and the same is to be addressed to The Registrar, UBKV, Pundibari, Cooch Behar. Original certificates are to be produced at the time of interview. No T.A. /D.A. is admissible for appearing the interview. The University reserves the right not to select any candidate for the above mentioned posts.
